

WATER AND SEWER RATES INCREASE

At their August 17, 2011 meeting, the Wolfeboro Board of Selectmen voted:

To approve the adoption of new quarterly service fees for both water and sewer users to become effective for water and sewer usage during the period of October 1-December 31, 2011 which will be billed after January 1, 2012, as follows:

The impact of this increase for most residential customers is that the quarterly service charge will increase by \$6 per quarter, both for water and sewer services. The increase was needed to help pay for infrastructure improvements and to reduce operating deficits. The new rates will not show up until the first water and sewer bills in January, 2012.
