II. NH DES Dredge & Fill Application

Jonathan & Mary Cooperman 304 Sewall Road, Lake Winnipesaukee Tax Map #241-19 Expedited Minimum Impact

The applicant proposes the removal of an existing 3.5'x36.75' seasonal dock, removal of an existing damaged/deteriorated concrete anchoring pad from the bank which has been displaced due to impact from ice, installation of a 6'x40' seasonal dock with a 4'x6.5' concrete anchoring pad on shore and seasonal watercraft lifts. Access to the dock will utilize an existing footpath to the waterfront.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Jonathan and Mary Cooperman Expedited Minimum Impact application, Tax Map #241-19.
