**Trouble Calls:**

- 2/03/16, 9 Lewando Lane - voltage concern; is changing out lightbulbs repeatedly.  
2/04/16, 15 Fitting End Lane – cottage has no power.

2/05/16, Sandstrom Rd., Tuftonboro – large limb on primary.
