TOWN OF WOLFEBORO CONSERVATION COMMISSION DREDGE & FILL MEETING MINUTES September 30, 2019

Chairman Clark opened the meeting at the Town Hall Annex conference room at 9:00 am.

Homebase East Trust 464 Sewall Road Lake Winnipesaukee Standard Dredge & Fill Tax Map #229-3

The applicant proposes to rebuild and existing boathouse and dockage; reducing two cribs to 8' wide, reducing construction surface area over public submerged lands by 45.8 SF, make the boathouse slip a standard 12' wide and move the boathouse structure south approximately 5' for symmetrical interior space/walks.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission has no objection to the Homebase East Trust application, Tax Map #229-3, as submitted.

Donald Satterfield 5 Umbrella Point Lake Winnipesaukee Standard Dredge & Fill Tax Map #213-18

The applicant proposes to add a new finger dock onto an existing breakwater with cantilevered dock.

Referencing the Donald Satterfield Standard Dredge & Fill application, Tax Map #213-18, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission understands the safety concerns presented by a docking system located on "The Broads" of Lake Winnipesaukee, which encounter tremendous wave action during the summer boating season. As such, we do not object to the proposed project. However, we feel it would be less impacting if the proposed finger dock was seasonal rather than permanent.
