Kurt Dietzer Revocable Trust 64 Parker Island Road Lake Winnipesaukee Permit By Notification Tax Map #226-5

The applicant proposes to replace poles in breakwater for cantilevered dock and repair slope on end of breakwater.

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Kurt Dietzer Revocable Trust Permit By Notification Fill application, Tax Map #226-5.

The applicant proposes to add a seasonal canopy to the existing docking structure on the boat slip adjacent to the breakwater (amendment to NH DES Wetlands Permit #2013-01014).

The Wolfeboro Conservation Commission noted no objection to the Robert Simmonds amendment to the NH DES Wetlands Permit #2013-01014, Tax Map #213-20.

Joshua A. Siegel 2003 Revocable Trust 17 Stephenson Lane Special Use Permit Tax Map #244-19

The applicant proposes to construct a workshop, modify an existing driveway location and temporary impact of ground surface during construction within the wetlands buffer and setback.

Referencing the Joshua A. Siegel 2003 Revocable Trust Special Use Permit application, Tax Map #244-19, the Wolfeboro Conservation Commission reviewed the application and plans and noted that nothing on the application shows methods to control runoff from the driveways, roofs or other impervious surfaces. In addition, there was no indication that the stormwater management would result in no increase in flow from the site, into the abutting properties, to the intermittent stream or the downslope wetland.
