Simms has had 4 engineering studies done with differing costs. WHC purview is exterior, not money nor usage. Individuals may write a letter to the editor about cost concerns.

Libby Museum: Selectmen need a formal deed to the property. The historic building needs to be saved.

HC recommendations on WA: None..

New Business

NHDOT Rte. 28: Rte. 28 Study Committee recommends not widening road, only adding sidewalks, incorporate street trees, preserve historic buildings, reflect character of town, lower speed to 30 mph from town line to Pickering Corner, 20 mph in school zone. Brewster will not change entrance, not enough room for rotary, no traffic light. Monuments cannot be moved. Area is currently in failure at peak times.

Maggie will draft a letter to the DOT that WHC should be a consulting party.

NH Preservation letter: There is no incentive to belong.
