Mrs. Murray noted that they would need to seek permission of the Board of Selectmen for that.

Mrs. Ryan stated that it seems that a site walk of Lehner Street and these facilities sounds like the next step for committee.

The Committee determined to do a site walk on November 18th, 2022 at 9 AM.
