


Wolfeboro Parks and Recreation Monthly Activity Report

The Abenaki Winter Triathlon was a success this year despite having to alter the course. Our Progressive XC Ski Dinner sold out a month ahead of time and we had 58 people on the waiting list.

Winter Carnival events kept us busy throughout the month—whether planning and partnering with community groups to host events, publicizing the events, and hosting them here at Abenaki at the end of the month. We had a great turnout with

over 600 people registering and taking part in Winter Carnival events, over 494 skier visits during the week, and 200+ non-skier spectators taking part in events such as bouncy houses, fireworks and more at Abenaki on Saturday, February 27th. It was lower from last year, however we were not open a full week due to weather!
