Essential Job Functions:

This job includes but is not limited to:

- Light the fire in the lodge and start the water.
- Set up register verifying the cash and tickets and inventory on inventory sheet.
- Pull out concessions and products we are selling.
- Being aware of the status of supplies and leave a note and make supervisor aware: tickets, money (change), mitten inventory, food and drinks, etc...
- Responsible for cashing out the register- leaving \$100 in the drawer and doing a report with money in envelope labeled and placed in safe.
- Making sure everything is put away, cleaning done, any notes for the next shift, and set up ready for next day.
- Ski Lodge Selling tickets, snacks, cleaning, start and maintain fire, maintain supply of firewood, operate grill outside, etc.
- Monitor behavior of guests. Enforce basic behavior rules of lodge: no profanity, bullying, etc.
- Making sure peoples stuff is not blocking doorways or floor space.
- Maintaining order and organization in lodge.
- Stocking fridge and making lists of what is needed.
- Great Customer Service is the most important part of this position!
