GENERAL SUMMARY

The Summer Maintenance Crew will perform basic maintenance tasks throughout Wolfeboro's 5 Parks, 3 Beaches, Public Buildings and Grounds,, Ice Arena, Ski Area, Town Cemeteries and other facilities. Working under the direction of the Maintenance Crew Leader, the Maintenance Crew will complete projects that make Wolfeboro a more safe and beautiful place for residents and visitors alike. The Maintenance Crew will serve in the eye of the public and we expect the highest level of Customer Service and ability to interact in a positive manner with the public. This is a seasonal position that runs from mid-May through mid-September. The position is 40 hours per week, Monday through Friday, 7am to 3pm.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Mowing, trimming and turf care in Wolfeboro's many parks, public grounds, cemeteries and other outdoor areas.
- Basic pruning and small tree removal.
- Landscaping, weeding and planting.
- Raking, cleanup and debris removal.
- Trash pickup and public restroom cleaning.
- Trail clearing and maintenance.
- Painting buildings, benches and fences.
- Set up and take down for Special Events.
- Perform basic carpentry and plumbing projects.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience

- High School graduate or at least 18 years of age preferred.
- 2 seasons of landscaping, trail maintenance or other outdoor work desired.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Must possess valid Driver's License with clean driving record.
- Ability to operate "push" and ride-on lawn mowers and other power equipment.
- Ability to safely operate a chainsaw.
- Ability to use a variety of hand tools such as shovels, pruners, etc...
- Basic Carpentry and Plumbing skills desired.
