Notice is hereby given that the Town of Wolfeboro will accept sealed bids for the disposal of equipment associated with the decommissioned municipal fire alarm system. Sealed bid proposals shall be sent plainly marked, "BIDS FOR MUNICIPAL FIRE ALARM EQUIPMENT" on the outside of the envelope and addressed to:

Bidders shall use the attached bid form.

The Town of Wolfeboro reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technical or legal deficiencies, and to accept any bid that it deems to be in the best interest of the Town.

This RFP consists of two parts:

Proposal 1: Gamewell master boxes with trip unit; street boxes without trip unit. The successful proposal will be for the lot. There are approximately 54 units, some with internal trip (masterbox) some without internal trip device (street box). The successful bidder shall make payment to the Town within three (3) days of formal award of the bid. The successful bidder shall pick up the equipment at the Wolfeboro Fire-Rescue Department within 15 days of the formal award of the bid, or another bidder will be chosen. The devices are sold "where is, as is." No warranty of merchantability is expressed or implied. Proposal 2: 1-Municipal fire alarm panel consisting of: 2 common cards with meters; 4 box circuit cards; 1 spare card; 1 cage card. 1-Battery charger/power supply 24 VDC. 1-Punch register with take-up reel. Entrance cabinet fuses (lot). Nicopress sleeves (lot). The successful bidder shall make payment to the Town within three (3) days of formal award of the bid. The successful bidder shall pick up the equipment at the Wolfeboro Fire-Rescue Department within 15 days of the formal award of the bid, or another bidder will be chosen. The devices are sold
