1. Summary of Request

The Town of Wolfeboro is seeking bids from qualified firms interested in providing fuel oil, diesel, unleaded fuel, and propane to the Town of Wolfeboro.

The contract term is July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024.

2. Intent

The Town's intent and the requirements of this Request for Bids are to provide the Town with the appropriate level of service, in the best interest of the Town, as determined by the Town in their sole discretion.

3. Submission of Responses

- b. Bids must be received no later than **3:00 PM**, **Thursday June 22**, **2023**. It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure the bids are received before the deadline.
- c. Any bids received after the specified date and time will not be considered, nor will late bids be opened.

4. <u>Background</u>

a. Town

The Town has nine (9) properties, each property has different storage capacities, and some locations have multiple services. Tank size, fuel type, average gallons per year and Town delivery locations are listed in Appendix A.

b. Town

The Town has propane fill locations, heating oil fill locations, dyed off road diesel fill locations, clear diesel locations and an unleaded fueling station.

5. <u>Scope of Services Required</u>

Bidders may bid on fuel oil or propane or both. Bidders may bid on just unleaded fueling station and diesel.

#2 Fuel Oil

If providing a bid for fuel oil, the successful bidder will be responsible for delivering fuel oil to all locations.

Propane

If providing a bid for propane, the successful bidder will be responsible for delivering propane to all Town locations. The successful bidder will be responsible for providing proper and adequate propane tanks including any and all costs associated with installing proper tanks and connecting them to building systems, including making arrangements with current tank owners. Regarding underground tanks, pricing should be quoted to accommodate the servicing of the tanks without removing them. The successful bidder will retain all liability related to the propane tanks, their care and upkeep, and any required or necessary maintenance of said tanks.

Unleaded fuel and diesel fuel

If providing a bid to supply regular unleaded gasoline to our fueling location and/or diesel fuel to our fueling location, this will be for a one (1) year contract period; Deliveries are typically requested on "will call" for anywhere between 1,000-4,000 gallons per delivery.

Equipment Inspection/Testing

Within ninety (90) days of award of contract, the successful bidder shall:

- Perform cathodic testing on all underground tanks
- Perform visual safety inspection on all propane and oil tanks
