COORDINATION WITH OUTSIDE AGENCIES

Policy

Coordination with other agencies is critical to the effective operation of the department. The Chief of Police reserves the right to decide policy concerning other agencies. However, other police managers and employees should promote cooperation with other agencies in the interest of serving and protecting the public.

Purpose

This directive establishes duties regarding coordination with adjoining law enforcement agencies and with other criminal justice, public safety, and traffic agencies.

Responsibilities

Liaison with other Law Enforcement Agencies

The Chief of Police along with the Executive Officer/Captain shall maintain liaison and meet as needed with representatives of other local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies to discuss policy and coordination.

1. SSgt, Sgt(s), shall maintain liaison with local law enforcement agencies and with adjoining jurisdiction.
2. Dispatch Supervisor liaison with local law enforcement agencies with adjoining jurisdiction.

The Service Division Sergeant is responsible for management information, community outreach (speaker's bureau, crime prevention, juvenile programs and community policing), school resource officer and related programs, juvenile prosecutions (referrals and DCYF liaison), and emergency medical services liaison.

The Service Division Sergeant coordinates community outreach endeavors and programs. Devise implement and control community policing initiatives.

SOP 1.10**Coordination with Outside Agencies**

The Service Division Sergeant assists in the development and implementation of management information programs. Works with providers and contractors to assure continuous operation and proper functioning of equipment. Troubleshoot issues, to the extent possible, to rectify problems within the system. Assist the officer in charge of the details with updates and following the proper work zones.

The Service Division Sergeant establish liaison and lines of communication with other EMS components of the Town, Huggins Hospital and surrounding communities, in order to keep the department aware of new procedures. Help to ensure the continued efficiency of police department functions.

The Service Division Sergeant act as liaison to D.C.Y.F. and the Child Advocacy Center.

The Service Sergeant shall oversee the official social media account(s) for the Wolfeboro Police Department. He/she shall be created and maintained by the Service Sergeant and overseen by the Captain/Executive Officer.
