Policy

- To fully comply with U.S. Public Law 95-393 dealing with diplomats.
- To provide legal assistance to foreign nationals.

Purpose

The purpose of this order is to cover the following:

- Diplomatic rights

- Foreign nationals arrested

- Foreign national assistance

- Political asylum

Consular Notification

- "Consular notification and access" by the U.S. Department of State will be maintained in the dispatch room and on file and, contain translations of foreign national's rights.
- Emergency State Department phone numbers.
- Consulate phone numbers.
