Policy

• Provide escort services consistent with the Mission Statement.

• Shall not escort civilian vehicles in medical emergencies.

Purpose

The purpose of this order is to cover:

Dignitaries Funerals

Oversized or Unusual Cargo Medical Emergencies

Money Escorts Reporting

Safety Escorts

General Guidelines

- Escorts shall be provided for any person or company needing safe passage.
- It shall only be provided if personnel are available.
- If time allows, the request must be in writing to the Chief of Police.

Procedures

Dignitaries	Normally escorted by their own security people Written request needed outlining; - number of officers needed - locations - known security risks

Money Escorts	Provided, if personnel are available
