Policy	To allow the release of prisoners in the shortest amount of time through the NH Bail Statute.	
Purpose	The purpose of this Order is to cover:	
	Bail	Responsibilities
Bail	 The purpose of Bail (RSA 597:2) is to: Ensure the appearance of the accused at Court. Assure the safety of the community. The release order serves as a specific guide as to the subject's conduct. 	
Bail Commissioner	The Officer will contact a Bail Commissioner who is available. If one is not available or special circumstances exist, the subject can be released on a hand summons.	
Cash Bail	If unable to post bail, the subject will be transported to Carroll County Correctional Facility.	
No Bail	Offenses punishable by death or murder in the first degree (RSA597:1) Violation of Protective Order CANNOT be placed on bail, but detained until	

arraignment. (RSA173B:9Ia) (RSA169-C:21-a)
