Policy To find alternative placement for persons taken into protective custody

because of intoxications or incapacitated individuals that come into contact

with the police.

Purpose The purpose of this directive is to cover:

Protective custody Alternative placement

Carroll County Correctional Facility

General Procedures

Persons taken into protective custody will be released to a competent adult or

an accepted alternative placement facility.

If all possible options have been exhausted the Carroll County Correctional

facility shall be used.

All provisions of SOP's in dealing with prisoners, transporting and safety are

to be complied with.

Reports

All relevant reports shall be completed regardless of who they are released to

prior to end of duty or as soon as reasonably possible.
