Want to help solve local crimes and assist the police with ongoing investigations? The Wolfeboro Police Department is currently establishing a Security Camera Registration Program. This strictly voluntary program will allow residents and business owners to register their address as a location that operates a video monitoring system, allowing police officers to readily identify locations throughout town with video surveillance.

Participation in the program does not allow open access for police to view or monitor citizen's video surveillance systems, rather simply provides a list of who has an operating system should something arise in the area. If an incident occurs, an officer would contact the participant for permission to view any footage.
