## **Minutes from the April 1, 2019 Cyanobacteria Committee (CBC) Meeting**

- 1- A motion was made by Mary to approve minutes from 3/4/19 as corrected, seconded by Kathy, motion approved.
- 2- Discussed posting of meeting minutes and agendas, posting on Town webpage and a bulletin board.
- 3- Subcommittee discussions:

**Subcommittee #1 Assessing** - Warren filled us in on what the group has been doing. Their group has invited Steve Wingate (Chair of the Tuftonboro Conservation Commission and resident on Winter Harbor) to join the subcommittee. Members of the committee met with Bob Craycroft (head of the UNH volunteer water monitoring program) and Jim Haney (UNH's lead expert on cyanobacteria.) Jim will be the Keynote Speaker at the Water Summit. He plans on bringing students to Winter Harbor in September. The only cost will be \$1,000 for kits to analyze the different classes of cyanotoxins. Warren mentioned they may need a go-pro. It was mentioned that the Lake Sunapee Association has been in existence since 1818.

General discussion about working on prevention of future problems and improving water quality. Warren did present a type written update on his subcommittee actions and notes of meeting. Marie to have posted

**Subcommittee #2 Mitigation & Prevention** - Dave said his committee hasn't met yet. Dave is working with Underwood Engineers on Carry Beach Parking Lot Stormwater Treatment & the septic system analysis Scope of Work. Wants recommendations for improvements with hope of funding and construction in 2020. Dave working with Staff and consultants will complete 3 projects as presented at Town meeting this year. The Watershed Management Plan, Partridge Drive (BMPs), and Carry Beach. A purchase order will be made for the Lake Winnepesaukee Association for \$15,000 for the Watershed Management Plan for Winter Harbor.

**Subcommittee #3 Communications** – Anne talked about working on the Water Summit, going forward working with other committees and community outreach. Dave mentioned one message a month for example with the electric bills. Also putting the message in layman’s terms. Discuss need to be careful with Communications and messages; no need to rush; use of other Associations Water Quality Messages.

4 – Each Subcommittee should develop a Schedule going forward – work on major action items and how to implement them.

5 - The Water Summit on May 11<sup>th</sup> was talked about.
