(formerly known as VERIZON), a limited liability company organized under the laws of Delaware having its principal place of business at 64 Regional Drive, Concord, New Hampshire 03301, their respective successor and assign forever, with warranty covenants, the RIGHT and EASEMENT to construct, repair, operate, maintain, patrol, replace and remove overhead and underground lines consisting of wires, cables, ducts, poles and other apparatus necessary for the transmission and distribution of electricity and/or telephone service on, over, and under my/our land in New Hampshire, more particularly described as follows:

Meaning and intending to describe and convey an easement over and across property of the grantor acquired by deed of _____ dated _____ and recorded at the Carroll County Registry of Deeds at Book _____, Page _____.

This conveyance shall include the right to clear and keep clear a right-of-way of all trees and underbrush by such means as the grantee may select.

The Location of said right-of-way shall be determined by mutual consent and become permanent upon installation of said lines.

The width of the right-of-way shall not exceed _____ feet. Necessary guy wires and anchors may be located beyond the cleared area.

The grantor shall continue to enjoy use of the property for any purposes not adverse to the grantee's rights. Planting of trees, building of structures, or storage of lumber and/or other materials within the granted right-of-way shall not be taken without the grantee's knowledge and consent. The grantee agrees to make reasonable modification of the lines within the grantor's property at the grantor's expense to accommodate future needs of the grantor in the use of his property.

The grantor (s) release to the grantee (s) all rights of dower/curtsey, homestead and or other interests in the rights and easements hereby conveyed.
