The committee met with staff of CEI, Horizon Engineers, Town Manager, Brad Harriman, Tavis Autin, Jason Durrance and the residents who will be required to hook up to the new sewer line extension on Sewall Road and Forest Road.

CEI explained the problem with E. coli in the wetlands and in the Carry Basin as it enters into Jockey Cove. The Town will be investigating whether the E. Coli is coming from animals or humans.

The Horizon Engineers and Town Staff answered the residents' questions regarding which pump should be used. Both a grinder pump and an effluent pump could be used. There were many concerns regarding the grinder pump. Horizon Engineers said they had designed the system for a effluent pump but DES does not like effluent pump systems. The Town Staff will work with Horizon Engineers to see if they can address the States issues with the grinder pump.

Warren Muir reported that the Assessing Subcommittee had met to discuss moving PER equipment to UNH and to plan the rest of 2023.
